Mayoral Election

The May 08th election has been cancelled. Only one person per position applied to run. This allows the Town to appoint them and forgo the expense of an election.

Opie Walter will continue on as Mayor and Greg Korbelic as Councilman. Robert Kellow will succeed Mike Tussy as Councilman. Councilmen David Gensler, Jim McCasland and John Scanlan will be serving the second year of their terms.

ETJ Development

The Developers on the proposed housing development on 600 acres of land directly north of Town hall in the Town's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) – i.e. buffer area have requested sewer permission from TCEQ and are awaiting their ruling. There is no developer's agreement with the Town at this point.

Permits

So far in 2010 permits were issued for 4 accessory buildings, and 12 other (remodeling, demolition, sprinkler, fence, health and signs). If you are planning a home project call us first to see if a permit is required
